SCOPE

- Manage all CNC and manual machine centers, lathes, mills, support equipment, weld equipment, deburr equipment and personnel in support of on time delivery and quality.
- Analyze and plan work force and equipment utilization, space requirements and workflow.

- Maintain a safe, clean and organized work environment.
- Manage and sustain a preventive maintenance program throughout work centers.
- Coordinate repairs and maintenance regimens with outside vendors.
- Make recommendations to improve production methods, performance, equipment and quality of product.

- Manage machining, weld and deburr tooling inventory distribution and accountability.
- Analyze and resolve work problems and utilize collaboration for resolving problems, to include direct reports.

- Previous experience in CNC programming and welding a plus.
