**About The Organization:** Compton YouthBuild's (CYB) mission and purpose is to provide rigorous educational and occupational opportunities for at-promise young people from economically distressed areas who are invested in creating a sustainable future for themselves, their families and communities.

**About The Position:** Compton YouthBuild seeks to hire a part-time technology instructor to provide technology training specifically in the areas of troubleshooting, Internet security, networking, mobile devices, hardware, Windows and other operating systems, technologies and technical support with the intention of preparing our members/alumni for CompTIA+ certification. This position will report to the chief programs officer and be housed at 1108 N Oleander Avenue in Compton.

**Hiring Criteria:** The ideal candidate excels in a high-paced environment and has:

- ❖ Associate or Bachelor degree in Computer Science or equivalent industry experience with industry certifications such as CompTIA A+ to demonstrate knowledge base and the ability to "hit the ground running"; Microsoft Certified System Engineer (MCSE) also helpful
- ❖ Two-to-three years hands-on IT experience (can include internships or work/study)
- ❖ Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- ❖ The ability to integrate industry, professional and life experiences into a classroom-learning environment
- ❖ The capacity to maintain a high level of commitment to guide and motivate students in their goals
- ❖ A demonstrated ability to engage youth in meaningful, interesting and creative learning experiences
- ❖ Experience working with young people ages 18-24 from low-income backgrounds preferred
- ❖ A critical knowledge base of social and economic conditions facing our communities
- ❖ A sincere desire to assist young people to succeed, develop self-confidence and effective leadership skills; familiarity with various challenges and issues faced by youth from low-income communities
- ❖ Excellent oral and written communication skills; ability to make group presentations and facilitate group activities
- ❖ The ability to work effectively with minimal supervision, prioritize multiple tasks, manage competing priorities, meet deadlines with keen attention to detail
- ❖ Spanish language skills (desired)
