## CARE GIVER TRAINING – 3 WEEKS WORK – Part time / Full time

### WHAT WILL I LEARN?

This course prepares the students to be a beginning health care worker in a long-term care facility.

### HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAM?

This program consists of 100 hours of training including classroom training/laboratory instruction. Upon completion, Student will receive a certificate.

### WHAT DO GRADUATES DO?

Graduates may find employment in health related settings such as adult day cares, assisted living facilities, private duty agencies, companion care agencies, rehabilitation center and home care agencies. They can also work as Sitters for hospitals.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT TO EARN?

Care Givers salary can range anywhere from \$29,500 to over \$34,000 annually or a mean hourly rate of \$14.40 according to the California Employment Development Department depending on experience, prior education, location and other factors.

### HOW WILL I FIND A JOB?

AMC offers Career Placement assistance to those students who complete the program. Career fairs and one on one placement assistance is offered to all AMC graduates.

### HOW DO I PAY FOR MY EDUCATION?

AMC offers in house financing to those who qualify.
